

SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP / ACHIEVEMENT AWARD 2019

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Singapore Chinese Girls' School is offering Sports Scholarships / Achievement Awards to students with sports talents to study in the Independent Secondary School. Area of sports should preferably be within those sports sanctioned by the Singapore Schools Sports Council of Ministry of Education.

Candidates with good academic or progress records and the requisite achievements in a particular sports or game are welcomed to apply.

Subject to satisfactory performance and conduct, and the conditions stated herein, the awards will be renewed yearly to allow the scholarship recipient to continue her schooling in SCGS leading to the GCE 'O' Level Examination or Integrated Programme Examination at the end of Secondary 4. The scholarship recipient is required to continue in the sports or game through which she earned the award and to qualify for the school team for the duration of her studies in SCGS.

The SCGS Sports Scholarship

- **School fees** as charged by SCGS for local students for the year. Should the scholar also be in receipt of any other scholarship covering all or part of such fees, the Sports Scholarship will only cover the difference between the student's school fees (local rate) and such other sum due to her as a benefit under any other scholarship(s).

The SCGS Sports Achievement

- This is a one-time \$500 award given to students.

Eligibility for Application

- 1 (a) Attain Top 8 positions in the Individual Category in National Competitions endorsed by National Sports Associations or Singapore Schools Sports Council
 - (b) Attain Top 4 positions in the Team Category in National Competitions endorsed by the National Sports Associations or Singapore Schools Sports Council. Please note that Doubles or Duet events are considered as Team Category
 - (c) Achieve the equivalent standard in similar/relevant competitions overseas [The school reserves the right to accord its own ranking to such competitions]
 - (d) Represented Singapore or MOE Singapore Schools at International competitions
- 2 Display exemplary conduct and behaviour (attain at least Very Good for Conduct)
 - 3 Meet the conditions of passing the examinations of the previous academic year.
 4. Pass a skills test (if required by SCGS) and may be called for an interview (for new 2019 Secondary 1 students)

Application (New & Renewal)

1. The application form for either new applicant or renewal of scholarship are available on Ask & Learn for 2018 Sec 1-3 SCGS students and on the school website (end of Dec 2018) for 2019 Secondary 1 students. Please fill in application form completely.
2. Please submit the following documents (photocopies) together with the application form :
 - Applicant's Birth Certificate or other Certificate of Identification used for reference in this application (New 2019 Secondary 1 students only)
 - PSLE Results Slip showing Aggregate Score and Grades (if applicant is in Sec 1 2019)
 - Previous 2 years' academic and CCA sports achievements
 - CCA records verified by teacher-in-charge or CCA records printout
 - Other relevant certificates or records in support of declared participation or achievements stated above in Eligibility for Application.
